- 2. Whose spirit of volunteering has made a remarkable impact on the lives of the girls, the league and community.
- 3. Who recognizes that honesty and loyalty is first above all else.
- 4. Who promotes sportsmanship and teamwork to enrich the lives of those around them.
- 5. Who strives to enhance the development of the league through unselfishness and hard work.
